If you did not get your photo taken for our new directory, you may do so on Sunday, June 2, from 9:00 to 10:00 AM.

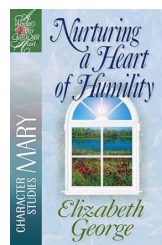
2024 GRADUATES
